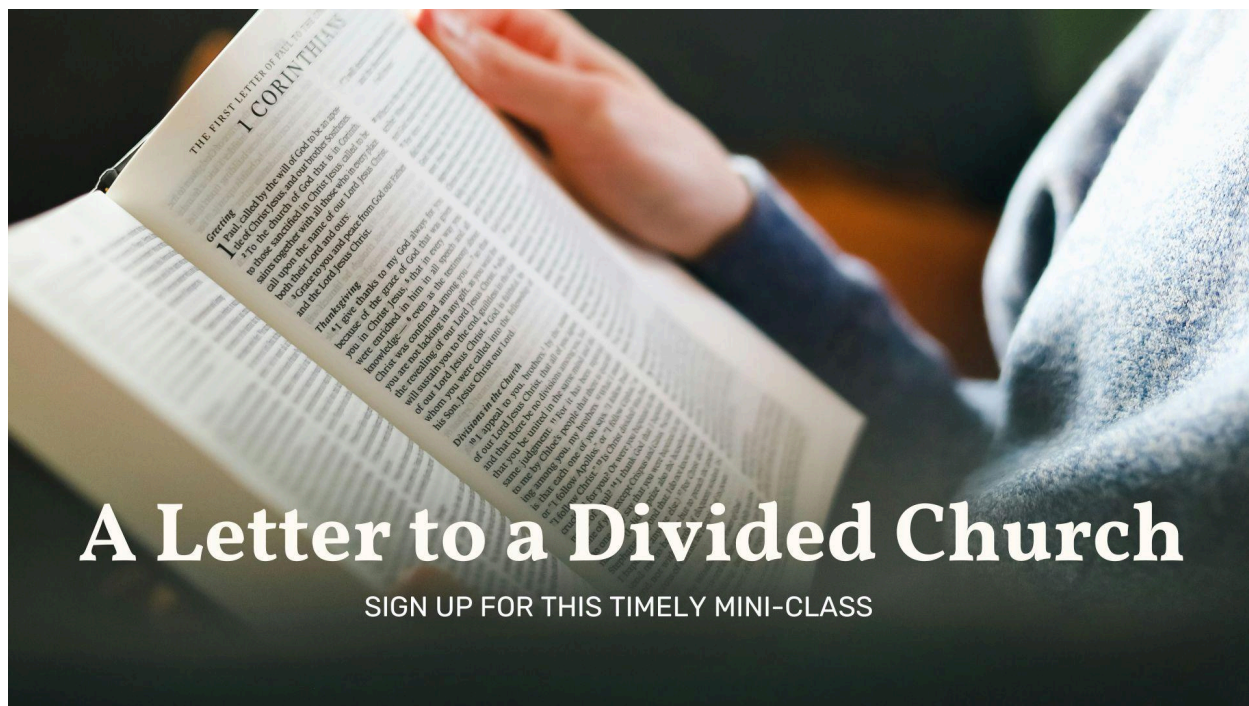




JOIN ME AS TOGETHER WE EXPLORE
